# The WiSE Transport Scheme



Wetherby in Support of the Elderly (WiSE) is a registered charity organisation which aims to enable older people to live at home, whilst reducing social isolation.

The Transport Scheme is a volunteer led service which provides a door-to-door pick up and drop off for people over 60 who are less mobile, vulnerable, don't drive, or struggle with public transport.

The service – which operates in Wetherby and surrounding areas – has a number of trusted volunteer drivers who will collect a service user and drive them to local healthcare appointments, WiSE activities, or to meet up with friends.

Although volunteers are providing their own time, they will be reimbursed by the passenger for the mileage used, detailed on page 4.

## Interested?

If you would like to volunteer as a driver, you will be given advance notice of a booking.

Volunteers will be providing transport for journeys that other transport schemes do not cover. For example, the service does not provide transport for hospitals.

Each booking will provide one return trip per weekday.

You will be paid £2 per journey, plus 45 pence for every mile travelled by the passenger, upon reaching their destination. You will be provided with a receipt book to give each passenger a receipt to sign.
